### Marsha's Downtown High School Class

Meet Marsha's high school class at Downtown Jewish Community School. To introduce her class to JF&CS and teach them about the agency's impact on the community, Marsha organized a summer camprelated fundraiser for her students. She wanted to demonstrate the importance of philanthropy and giving back to the community.

Marsha's class began exploring tzedakah projects in September of 2021, choosing to contribute to initiatives that were meaningful to them. For their final project, the class decided to put together backpacks full of camp necessities for children in JF&CS's Jewish camp subsidies program, facilitated by Kits for a Cause. Kits for a Cause is an organization that connects charities across North America with groups and individuals looking to get involved, give back, and make an impact.

After the students collected donations for the project, Marsha's class filled the backpacks with beach towels, water bottles, sunscreen, and sun hats. The students also wrote thoughtful notes for the recipients to read. Even though they did not know the recipients of these backpacks, each student felt they forged a personal connection with the person receiving the gift. This project was so meaningful to the students of Marsha's class that they have decided to repeat it again for next year!

Meet the mothers and daughters of Ulpanat Orot Girls School. A group of grade 12 students were the driving force behind a Chessed project designed to give back to the community. The students donate to and volunteer at a variety of different organizations and wanted to contribute in a meaningful way.

The grade 12 students were tasked with coming up with a school-wide program for students and their families. After looking into several organizations, JF&CS seemed to align perfectly. The agency focuses on providing a multitude of supports to strengthen families, and the girls at Ulpanat Orot decided it was a terrific choice for this family-oriented program.

In addition to hearing from Rabbi Mordechai Chemel, Manager of Chaplaincy at JF&CS, about the history of women and their involvement in the Jewish community, the students and their families helped create Grief Kits for JF&CS clients in our Grief


